Carbon Monoxide Detectors

The Woodland Sunrise Rotary Club and the Yolo County Board of REALTORS® has teamed up to offer a unique health and safety program to the residents of Woodland.

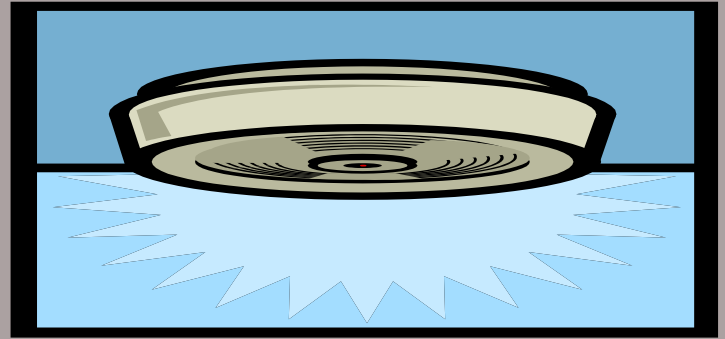
The two organizations have purchased 400 carbon monoxide detectors to create awareness as well as provide residents of Woodland with devices to comply with the new law. This will help our local community increase our health and safety with these devices.

It's The Law:

The Carbon Monoxide Poisoning Act of 2010 requires carbon monoxide detectors to be installed in every "dwelling unit intended for human occupancy." After two years, studies show that fewer than 25% of the homes have carbon monoxide detectors installed.

Cooperators:

We are working with Meals on Wheels, Woodland Senior Center, Yolo County Food Bank, Woodland Fire Department and the Woodland Community Care Car to help promote this program and get the word out to qualified residents. Please feel free to contact any of these groups for additional information.
